COLLEGE OF MEDICINE MATCH DAY 2014 RESULTS

PEORIA (March 21, 2014) – More than 40 medical students from the University of Illinois College of Medicine at Peoria joined thousands across the country Friday as they learned where they “matched” to complete residency programs in their chosen medical career path.

Residencies are the three to seven years of on-the-job training that medical-student graduates must complete after medical school. Not only is it required before they can practice medicine in the U.S., but residencies often determine where a doctor will practice. About 60 percent of primary care physicians in the Peoria area trained at a University of Illinois program.

In Peoria, all 70 residency positions were filled. The College has about 250 residents enrolled in 11 residency programs affiliated with OSF Saint Francis Medical Center and UnityPoint Health - Methodist. About 12,000 students nationwide applied and nearly 800 interviews were held.

One of four campuses that make up one of the largest public medical school in the U.S., the University of Illinois College of Medicine at Peoria educates more than 150 medical students annually and offers 20 graduate medical training programs. The College is home to the cutting-edge Cancer Research Center and a partner in Jump Trading Simulation & Education Center.
