PEORIA – (May 5, 2014) Get a glimpse of the high-level, wide range of research taking place in central Illinois – research that has an impact on patient care.

The 10th Annual Research Symposium on Tuesday, May 6 at Jump Trading Simulation and Education Center includes research from across all medical disciplines in a wide variety of fields.

More than 40 research posters will be displayed. Studies include a look at the length of time women received an abnormal mammogram to getting a biopsy results; a nine-month look involving more than 120 lactating mothers and measuring caloric and macronutrient contents in breast milk; and a look at non-alcoholic fatty liver disease and bariatric surgery in obese adolescents.
